5. (5 points) Simplify the following, if possible. Avoid all radicals and negative exponents. All fractions must be in reduced form. Brackets must be removed. Like terms must be combined.

$$\frac{\left(\frac{(2xy^{-1}z^4)^3}{3x^2y}\right)}{\left(\frac{(3x^{-2}y^4z^2)^2}{5yz^5}\right)}$$

6. (5 points) Write as a single fraction and simplify:

$$3x - 5 + \frac{1}{2x - 1} - \frac{3}{\frac{1}{2}x + \frac{1}{3}}.$$

 - (a) (5 points) $(2x-1)^3$

(b) (5 points) $(x+2)^2(x-2)^2$

- 8. Completely factor the following
 - (a) (5 points) $q^2 + 3q 28$

(b) (5 points) $t^6 + 7t^3 - 8$

- 9. Solve
 - (a) (5 points) 5w + 4 = 19 + 2w

(b) (5 points) $(x-6)^2 - 16 = 0$


(c) (5 points) f(f+2) = (f-1)(2f+3)

11. (5 points) Write the domain of $f(x) = \frac{\sqrt{x+4}}{x^2+3x-4}$ using set-builder notation.


12. (10 points) Consider the graph of the polynomial p(x).
